Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union's Tawas City Branch Raises \$364.79 and Donates Dozens of Coats to the Iosco County Coats for Kids Program

Tawas City, Michigan, July 11, 2011— The Tawas City branch of Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union presented the Iosco County Coats for Kids program with a check for \$364.79 plus dozens of coats for local needy children.

Iosco County Coats for Kids distributes new and used coats through the local school system in the fall to any child in need. The volunteer-run program also maintains an inventory of coats throughout the winter for shelters, nursery and Head Start schools, and any local emergency requirement.

Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union employees select four community or charity organizations that they would like to fundraise for during each quarter of the year. During the 2nd quarter of 2011 (April 1st through June 30th) the staff of the Tawas City Branch, located at 118 W. M-55, raised money and collected coats for needy children in their community. Staff organized many different fundraisers. Candy bars were sold at teller windows, and staff could donate \$2.00 on Fridays to dress down in jeans and sneakers. The staff also raffled a "Grilling Gift Basket."
