Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union Lincoln Branch Adopts-A-Highway

Alpena, Michigan, August 31, 2018 – Team members from Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union’s (AAACU) Lincoln Branch helped keep Alcona County clean.

Employees from the Lincoln Branch have adopted a three-mile stretch along US 23 for the third year in a row with the Adopt-A-Highway program. Each year team members head out in the spring, summer, and fall to clean up their section of the highway.

The Lincoln team enjoys volunteering their time to clean up their section of the highway and bonding with their coworkers while making an impact on their community.
