*Alpena, MI, July 03, 2019* - Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union (AAACU) recently aided in the financing process for the Alpena Township Fire Station to purchase two new ambulances.

This past November Alpena Township residents voted to pass a millage approving a new property tax to provide new equipment to the Township Fire Station. With this new property tax, the township was able to purchase two much-needed ambulances equipped with lift technology allowing EMT's the ability to maneuver heavier patients safer and without harm to their back.
