Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union Donates to Alcona County Commission on Aging

Alpena, Michigan, July 11, 2022 – Through the hard work and dedication of its employees and the generosity of its membership, Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union (AAACU) Lincoln Branch raised \$515.74 in monetary donations for Alcona County Commission on Aging (ACCOA).

The ACCOA founded in 1973 works to promote independence, well-being, and dignity of the again population in Alcona County. Funds from the credit unions donation will be used for ACCOA’s home delivery meal program. This program helps ensure seniors are receiving nutritional meals and helps seniors live independently longer.

In addition to member donations, team members held raffles and donated \$2.00 per employee dress down on Fridays to help raise money.

AAACU serves members primarily in Alpena, Alcona, Montmorency, and Iosco counties with ten locations: a main office located in Alpena, a Wildcat Branch in Alpena High School and with branch offices in Ossineke, Lincoln, a Tiger Branch in Alcona Community Schools, Atlanta, Oscoda, the Owl’s Nest in Oscoda Area Schools, Tawas, and an additional branch in Alpena. As of May 31, 2022, AAACU, provides service to 32,980 members with total assets equal to \$563,374,267.
