AAACU Aids in Tornado Relief

Alpena, Michigan, June 06, 2022 – Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union (AAACU) and the Blue Ox Chapter of Credit Unions partnered to assist community members effected by recent storms in Otsego County

On May 20, 2022, a large tornado and storm hit the Gaylord Michigan area causing damage to residents and businesses. AAACU and the Blue Ox Chapter of Credit Union organized relief efforts to provide grants to assist community members to offset the cost caused by the unexpected storm. The tornado covered over sixteen miles consisting of residential areas and businesses. Nottingham Forest, a low-income mobile home park lost seventy of its seventy four homesites, leaving families with significant loss.

Credit Unions have a motto of ‘People Helping People’ and AAACU is fortunate to partner with other local credit unions to provide financial support to those impacted by the storm.
