Volunteers were paired with 6th through 12th grade students from Alcona, Alpena, and Montmorency county to help purchase clothing, shoes, personal hygiene products and school supplies for the upcoming school year.

This is the third year United Way of Northeast Michigan has been able to provide this event to students in need, and due to donations received from within Northeast Michigan 33 students were able to benefit from this program.
