Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union Sponsors Community AED Device for Culligan Plaza with the Alpena Fire Department



Alpena, MI—Alpena Alcona Area Credit Union (AAACU) recently donated \$647 to the Alpena Fire Department (AFD) to support the placement of an Automated External Defibrillator device that in Culligan Plaza in Downtown Alpena at the intersection of Second Avenue and Chisholm Street. The donation will cover the cost of the climate-controlled cabinet where the AED will be placed. An AED is a device that can assist in reviving someone from sudden cardiac arrest.

This donation is a part of a larger project led by the AFD to identify high traffic and high risk locations where AEDs should be installed to ensure they are accessible to the public during emergencies. AAACU is proud to support local initiatives that improve the safety and wellbeing of

our community.

This donation is made possible by the credit union's Community Investment Fund. These funds are comprised of dollars donated back into our communities thanks to credit union members who choose to receive their monthly statements electronically. The credit union pledges to donate \$9.00 annually for each of these e-statements accounts. In 2026, AAACU will donate up to \$320,406.00 back into the communities they serve.
